

# Max Dice 2.0 Lite

Welcome to Max Dice Light – a flexible PC dice roller.

## Features

Up to three rolls can be combined together.

As many low dice can be tossed as needed,

Dice can be Maxed (set to maximum value)

Two Styles of open dice

The ability to toss the first roll if it's not high or low enough

Each of the three sections on top represent one set of dice – all three can be configured separately and are totaled together. That total is the modified by the multiplier on the bottom of the page.

Dice to Roll – This is the number of dice to roll.

Size of Dice – This is the highest value the dice can roll. The lowest value is 1.

Maxed Dice – The number of dice to set to the maximum value for that dice.

Tossed Dice – The number of dice that are discarded. For example 4 six sided dice with one tossed could roll a 5,6,2,2 giving us an 11 - 5,6,2,0.

Reroll High – the first time each die is thrown if it is higher than the value given – it is rolled again. That value is kept no matter what it is.

Reroll Low – the first time each die is thrown if it is lower than the value given – it is rolled again. That value is kept no matter what it is.

Open Dice Options.

None – No changes to the dice roll.

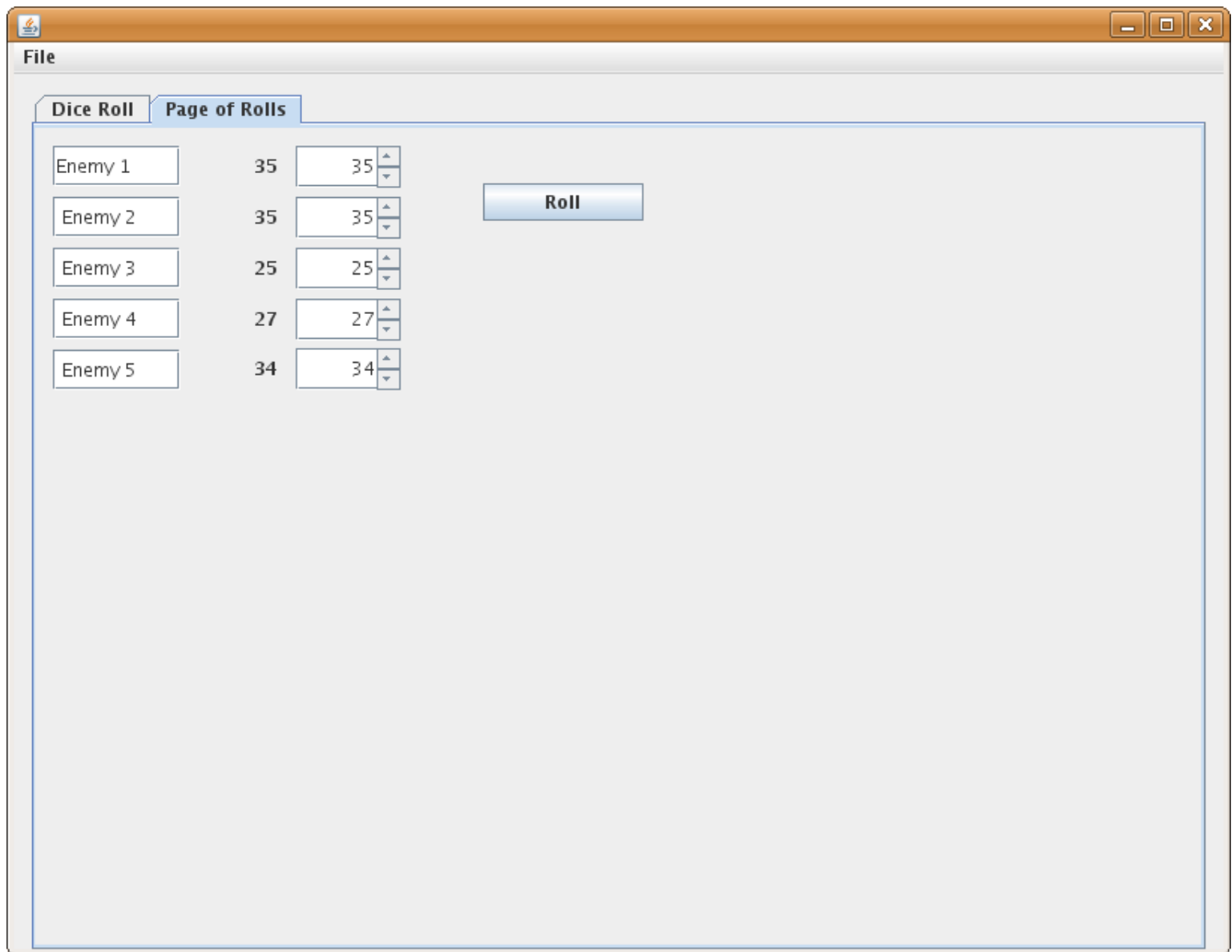
Classic – every time the maximum roll is rolled – the die is rolled again and added to the total.

True – every time the maximum is rolled – one is subtracted first – then the die is rolled again and added to the total.

Multiplier - All these options make the roll for that section. That value has the multiplier applied to it.

One Time Bonus – This is the last thing added to a roll.

All three rolls – are added together – and then on the lower section that Multiplier and One Time Bonus are added in.



On this page you can track multiple rolls. When you hit the roll button values are assigned to the text label and the value is put in the spinner (text box with up and down arrows). The text label holds the starting value and the spinner lets you adjust it, apply damage to the enemy etc.

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
